- You will apply industrial hygiene principles to control occupational health hazards associated with shipyard industrial work operations.
- You will review and provide comments and technical guidance for a wide variety of local and higher authority instructions, procedures, standards, and regulations.
- You will act as the PSNS point of contact for matters concerning the ergonomics program.
- You will be responsible for anticipating, recognizing, evaluating, and providing control recommendations and guidance primarily for ergonomic related hazards and general industrial hygiene. Communications with affected stakeholders must be strategically developed to assure a wide-ranging target audience can readily understand and implement requirements and guidance.
